

# Research Topics, Essay Questions, and Issue-Based Discussion Prompts

# **RIGHT TO LIFE**

- 1. Should abortion providers, including Planned Parenthood, receive taxpayer funds from federal, state, or local governments (including Title X grants)?
- 2. Should chemical abortion drugs meet essential safety standards (such as in-person consultation with a medical doctor) and require reporting by prescribers to gather evidence on reactions and outcomes?
- 3. Under what circumstances should an elective abortion be allowed?
- 4. Does the federal government have a role to play in limiting abortion, and if so what federal steps and/or federal legislation would you support?

## **ECONOMIC ISSUES**

- 1. What actions would you take that would allow Americans to retain more of their income and wealth?
- 2. Does student loan forgiveness unfairly shift the financial burden to those not responsible for student debt?
- 3. Should environmental and social issues, like ESG (environmental, social, and governance) ratings, be used as criteria in deciding where to invest public monies?

## **RELIGIOUS LIBERTY**

- 1. What does "separation of church and state" mean to you?
- 2. Should individuals and businesses be required to provide services even if it would violate their moral and/or religious beliefs?

## HEALTHCARE

- 1. Is healthcare a right established by the Constitution?
- 2. Should healthcare for all be guaranteed?
- 3. Should healthcare for all be funded by the taxpayers?
- 4. Should insurance for all be mandated by the government?

## NATIONAL SECURITY

- 1. When should the United States intervene in foreign conflicts?
- 2. What type of action is necessary to address threats to freedom around the world (e.g., diplomacy, economic sanctions, military intervention)?
- 3. What country or group poses the most serious military, cyber security, intellectual property, and economic threat to the United States (e.g., China, Russia, global terrorism)?
- 4. Is the United States relationship with Israel important? If so, why?
- 5. What are the causes of decline in U.S. military recruitment and retention?

#### 2<sup>ND</sup> AMENDMENT

1. What restrictions on gun ownership are needed to protect public safety?



### IMMIGRATION

- 1. Should the U.S. do more to physically secure the southern border?
- 2. Who should be allowed to immigrate to the U.S. and under what circumstances?

### EDUCATION

- 1. Should parents have a range of education and education funding options, including voucher programs, tax credits, charter schools, private schools, and home schools?
- 2. Should the U.S. Department of Education be eliminated and control given back to states and communities?

#### VALUES

- 1. Is marriage a God-ordained, sacred and legal union of one man and one woman? If so, does government have the authority to alter this definition?
- 2. Is gender ideology, grooming, and bodily mutilation merely abuse targeted at children?
- 3. Should taxpayer funds be used to provide gender transition services?

## **ELECTIONS AND VOTING**

- 1. Should people be able to vote without photo identification?
- 2. Should the Electoral College be abolished?

## EQUALITY

- 1. Are the institutions of the United States fundamentally racist?
- 2. Should biological males be allowed to participate in women's sports or occupy biological women's spaces whether it be bathrooms, locker rooms, sorority houses, women's shelters, or prison?
- 3. Based on each candidate's responses, how do you think he/she will vote/govern, if elected?

## ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

- 1. Is the climate changing?
  - a. If so, does it pose a global threat?
  - b. If so, is it due to human activity and/or enterprise?
  - c. If so, are there human remedies? Do the remedies, if any, require government funding and/or urgent political action?
- 2. What do you believe is the most reliable energy source that will supply the growing demand for electricity?
