TOMORROW: America Eagerly Watches Results of California Recall Election

As Last-Minute Voters Make Their Voices Heard, iVoterGuide Provides Key Information About Candidates

SACRAMENTO — With only one day left to vote in the California gubernatorial recall election, America watches with anticipation for answers to two key questions: Should Gavin Newsom be recalled from the office of Governor? Do some undecided voters even remember his positions? iVoterGuide provides documented reminders of his policies and executive orders, all referenced so that voters can verify for themselves.”*
