"Think of it: The men buried at Omaha Beach, in Normandy, France, which my daughter and I recently visited for Memorial Day, gave their lives for our American principles and ideals," says Wuthnow. "Those principles and ideals don't include, and never have, the promotion of homosexual behavior, transgender behavior, or any other kind of sexual immorality. They don't include, and never have, the government-imposed redefinition of family and gender. And they don't include, and never have, the criminal punishment and social 'canceling' of people who stand for biblical, traditional standards of family and sexuality."

Adds Wuthnow, "Will freedom survive—or will our Christian views be criminalized by elected officials? Will we lose our right to pass on our values to our children? And will our flag remain red, white, and blue—or will Christians be forced to salute the multicolored 'Rainbow Flag'?
